Singles, BOYS, and GIRLS

They will play 5 games; the top 4 SINGLES will play the semifinals and finals. The semifinal will be the 1st against the 4th and 2nd against the 3rd; winners will play for the first price and losers for the 3rd. being overall 64 athletes they will use 32 lanes, and the lane movement will be 6 lanes to the right for even numbers and 6 lanes to the left for odd numbers. Price fund we will as we have attached. Separate prices for Girls and Boys

Doubles BOYS and GIRLS - BAKER SYSTEM

They will play ten games (baker system), and each game will be in one lane. Athletes in the first position will play frames 1-3-5-7-9, and they can change the lineup after each game.

The top 4 DOUBLES will play in the semifinals and finals. The semifinal will be the 1st against the 4th and 2nd against the 3rd; winners will play for the first place and losers for the 3rd. Lane movement will be informed at the Manager meeting. Price fund we will as we have attached. Separate prices for Girls and Boys

Team Event BOYS and GIRLS - BAKER SYSTEM

They will play ten games (baker system), and each game will be in one lane; the Athlete in the first position will play frames 1-5-9, and the athlete in position number 2 will play 2-6-10, the number 3 frames 3 and 7, and the number 4 frames 4th and 8th. They can decide to change the lineup after each game.

The top 4 TEAMS will play in the semifinals and finals. The semifinal will be the 1st against the 4th and 2nd against the 3rd; winners will play for the first place and losers for the 3rd.

They will qualify the top 10boys of SINGLESplus the best 2 athletes fromColombia,Iceland, Mexico,Finland, EAB Mexico, and Peru(in total 12) plus 8 of Qatar (we have 4 teams) in a total of 30boys.

GIRLS

They will qualify the top 6 girls of the SINGLES, plus the best 2 athletes of each country, in total 12, will be in a total of 18 girls plus the 30 boys, they will have 48 athletes in total.

They will play a rhythm of 3 athletes per pair, using the 32 lanes, and the movement of the lane will be 6 lanes to the right: the whole group.

For this stage, all the athletes qualified will carry overthe pinfall of the SINGLES (5 games) and they will play 6 more games, total 11 for the qualification for the second stage.

Second Stage:Quarterfinals

The top 12 Boysand the top 8 Girlsof the First Stage of the Master they will play according to the following brackets: the top 4 Boys have a bye, so they qualify straight for the quarterfinals.
